SUBJECT	Agenda Item #4 – Elections of Board Officers

Business and Professions Code § 3014 states that the board shall elect from its membership a president, a vice president, and a secretary who shall hold office for one year or until the election and qualification of a successor. All officers may be elected on one motion or ballot as a slate of officers unless more than one Board member is running per office. An officer may be re-elected and serve for more than one term.

Pursuant to the <u>Board's Administrative Manual</u>, the Board President is required to solicit nominees not less than 45 days prior to the open election of new Board officers. Staff has compiled nomination forms and the statements from nominated candidates which are attached. The terms of President, Vice President and Secretary shall be effective until July 1, 2022 or a date determined by the Board.

Board President

Dr. Lillian Wang was nominated by Dr. Turetsky.

Dr. Wang's statement:

It is an honor to be nominated for President of the California State Board of Optometry. As a member of the Board, I deal with the intricacies of policy development, advocating consumer interests and enforcing laws to protect the public. During my tenure on the Board, I have been inspired by the dedication of the Board as it continues its pursuit of protecting the health and safety of the California consumer.
