The Board will recognize the service of Dr. Debra McIntyre, O.D., who served on the Board from March 15, 2016 until June 1, 2021.

Biography:

Debra McIntyre was appointed by Governor Brown as a professional member on March 15, 2016. McIntyre has been an optometrist at West Coast Eyecare since 2013, and from 2002 to 2003. She was chief executive officer and an optometrist at Accent on Eyes Optometry from 2003 to 2013. Previously, she was chief executive officer and an optometrist at Paradise Optical in Florida from 1999 to 2002. While in Florida, she served on the board of the Florida Keys Optometric Society. McIntyre is a member of the Escondido Sunrise Rotary and participated in various vision and eye health screening programs in Mexico and Haiti to serve the underprivileged. She earned her Doctor of Optometry degree from the Marshall B. Ketchum University, Southern California College of Optometry.
